AP® STATISTICS 2006 SCORING GUIDELINES (Form B) Question 4 Intent of Question The primary goal of this question is to assess a student's ability to conduct a test of significance by stating the hypotheses of interest, checking the necessary conditions, calculating the test statistic and p-value, and making a conclusion in context Solution

AP STATISTICS 2010 SCORING GUIDELINES (Form B)

Partially correct (P) if the response correctly identifies only one of the two components (either the name of the probability distribution or the parameter values) Incorrect (I) if the response neither correctly names the distribution nor identifies both parameter
